Sue Nesbitt called the meeting to order at 12:04 pm

SECRETARY’S REPORT: Tom motioned for approval of September Secretary’s minutes, Susan seconded, all approved.

TREASURER’S REPORT: “Gail motioned to increase the current 2023 budget for facility rental from \$1200. Budget is currently \$2,000 and will increase to \$3,200 to cover the deposit. Star seconded, all agreed. Liability insurance will remain unchanged and event insurance will be available if we choose to buy it. YCMGA set up their own non-profit corporation independent of OMGA in 2018. The appropriate tax returns and reporting forms were submitted from 2018 until 2021 when the new treasurer for OMGA filed the tax return on behalf of YCMGA under the OMGA tax ID number assuming we were still under the OMGA incorporation. The IRS has sent a notice requesting a tax return for year ending 12-31-2021 and an explanation why this was never filed. Susanne and Star will compose an explanatory letter to the IRS. In 2022 Susanne filed the tax return for YCMGA with our tax ID number so this notice only applies to 2021.”

An Issue with the IRS: In order to rent the fairgrounds several years ago, YCMGA had to incorporate, which we did. However, the new treasurer for OMGA did not file tax returns for YCMGA in 2021 though she did file tax returns for subsequent years. IRS demands a refund and a fine as punishment. Susanne and Star will compose an explanatory letter to the IRS, along with the taxes due.

Tom motioned to end the meeting at 11:18, seconded by Star (of course), and the shortest YCMGA board meeting in history concluded. The motivation was the potluck dinners staring at us from the nearby tables.
